Please Note:

- All archers must be members of Archery GB. Cards will be inspected at registration.
- Equipment will be inspected for compliance with rules according to category.
- Foam bosses supplied by Tenzone on both days
- Ends of six arrows in four minutes controlled by visual and audible signals
- ArcheryGB dress regulations are applicable to all archers. These do not apply to overseas visitors
- There will be no provision for crossbows or professional archers
- Spelthorne Archers and the Meadhurst Club cannot accept claims for any loss or damage sustained at the venue
- Spelthorne Archers will not be liable for arrows damaged in the target or because of pass-throughs
- Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party as this is a shared field. (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow)
- Access to the car park, shooting field and the Meadhurst Club building (including toilets) will be from 9.00am
- Free parking is available in the designated car park. No parking is permitted in the passing areas on the driveway into the Meadhurst Club
- Free tea and coffee throughout the day. The bar may be open at lunchtime, but no food is available- bring your own. Portable barbeques are not allowed.
- Pets are strictly not permitted
- For technical reasons, metal pegs for tents are prohibited. Plastic or wooden pegs only to be used.
